Chickens - There was much discussion regarding the possibility of allowing chickens in the village. There are several residents that have chickens now, mostly because they want the eggs. It was discussed how when they are sold, it's in packs of 6 so maybe we would want to limit the amount a resident can have to 6. Jim stated that he feels they would bring in rats and it's not a good idea to allow them in the village. The residents could get a permit at a cost of \$25 and it would have to be renewed every year on the anniversary date at which they got the permit the first time. The clerk would have to keep track of these permits and send out renewals. The Code Enforcement Officer would have to keep track of them. If they have more than allowed, Gary could give them a warning and so many days to remedy the issue, then they would be fined, possibly \$50 per day for non-compliance. As far as lot size, we would stay with the recommended lot size that the Village Attorney recommended.

Parking Lot - There was discussion as to how we would manage the parking at the new parking lot located behind 117 Main Street. There was discussion about permitting the last 10 spaces for overnight parking and the other spaces would be left empty. Possibly we could issue a permit, for a cost, to the car owner that does overnight parking.
