ARTICLE I

Explosive Materials

§ 90-1. Permission required for possession of certain explosives.

No person shall transport, store, sell, deliver, use or have in his possession in the Village of Windsor any explosives for any purpose, except gun powder in quantities of not more than five (5) pounds, without permission from the Mayor or Board of Trustees.

§ 90-2. Permission required for firing explosives.

No person or persons shall fire any gun, pistol, revolver or other thing charged with gun powder or other explosive material within the Village of Windsor at any time without permission of the Mayor or Board of Trustees.

§ 90-3. Penalties for offenses.*

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Article shall be liable to a penalty set forth in Appendix C of the Code of the Village of Windsor containing the list of Fines and Penalties for the Village or imprisonment for not more than fifteen (15) days, or both, for any offense.

ARTICLE II
Air Rifles and BB Guns

§ 90-4. Use Prohibited; penalties for offenses.*

The use of air rifles or BB guns anywhere within the limits of the Village of Windsor is hereby prohibited under a penalty set forth in Appendix C of the Code of the Village of Windsor containing the list of Fines and Penalties for the Village of imprisonment for not more than fifteen (15) days, or both, for each offense.
